



## Call for Projects PhDs' Mobility Program

*opening on 23 December 2020*

### 22nd Call for projects PhDs' Mobility Program, International opening of doctoral training

The mission of the Lille Nord de France Doctoral College is to provide professional support for doctoral students. It is a platform for consultation and coordination between doctoral schools. The 6 doctoral schools entrust it with the operational implementation of shared actions that complement their missions:

- 1) Strengthening the interdisciplinarity and internationalisation of doctoral training;
- 2) Preparing doctoral students for their future careers by working to create bridges between the academic world and other socio-economic players
- 3) To promote the doctorate and PhDs in civil society, through promotional actions and the setting up of events with the socio-economic world.

The Lille Nord de France Doctoral College wishes to contribute to the internationalisation of doctoral training by participating in the financing of outgoing mobility projects. The Collège Doctoral Lille Nord de France's call for projects entitled **PhDs' Mobility Program**, International Opening of Doctoral Training, **is published once a year**.

#### Eligibility criteria for application

- This call is addressed to all doctoral students enrolled in one of the 6 [doctoral schools](#) run by the University of Lille, IMT Lille-Douai, Central Lille Institut or the Polytechnic University Hauts de France
- PhD candidates will conduct their mobility **between 1 February and October 15, 2021**
- The content and relevance of the mobility: the project should explain how mobility will contribute to complement the doctoral training of the doctoral student
- The funding of the doctoral college is not intended to replace the normal funding of the thesis.
- Mobility must be for a minimum of **1 month and up to 6 months maximum**.
- A precise budget is requested, detailing travel, accommodation and subsistence costs. Co-financing of the mobility project is an important element in the allocation of support. Please note: the self-financing of doctoral students is not taken into account when calculating the budget.
- The request is not exclusive of other aids.

#### Are not eligible:

- Travel to the laboratory partner as part of a joint supervision / co-supervision of a thesis, travel for conferences / meetings / summer schools.
- Doctoral students enrolled in the 5th year and beyond for 2020-2021 are not eligible.

## Amount and procedure

The maximum amount of support is capped at **€2,500 per mobility project**. The allocated amount takes into account the destination and duration of the mobility.

The doctoral student's home laboratory will advance the costs. The funding is then paid to the doctoral student's laboratory at the end of the mission, on the basis of a scientific and financial report which must be sent to the doctoral college on the doctoral student's return. This report is a compulsory condition for the payment of aid to the laboratory.

## Calendar and selection process

**Deadline for submitting applications: online submission before January 20, 2021 at 5 p.m.**

- December 23, 2020: launch of the call
- January 20, 2021: Deadline for registration of the application and submission of the completed and signed files to <https://framaforms.org/aap-phds-mobility-2021-1608289249>.
- The doctoral schools send a ranking of applications to the doctoral college by January 27, 2021 at the latest.
- January 29, 2021: meeting of the selection committee
- Beginning of February 2021: notification of the attributions by the Doctoral College
- From February 1 to October 15: implementation of the mobilities

Any incomplete form or received after the closing date for registrations will not be taken into account
